

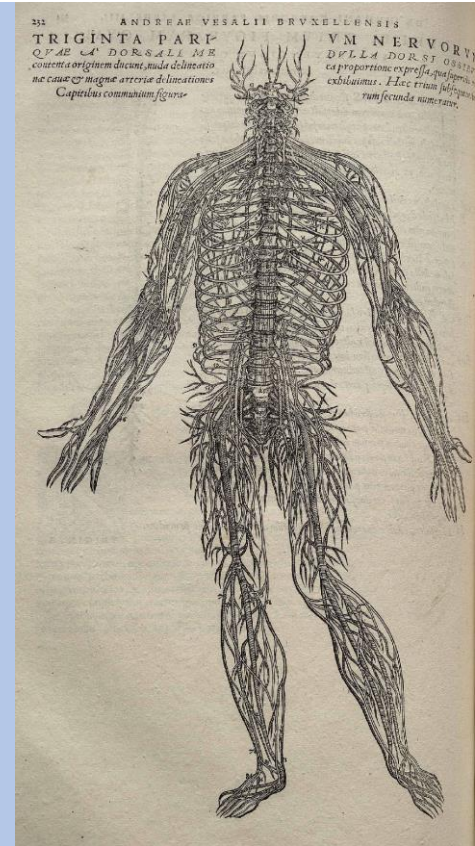

## Neurological disorders

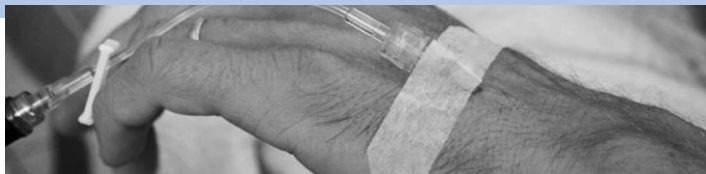
- Guillain-Barré syndrome
- Chronic inflammatory peripheral neuropathies
- Multifocal motor neuropathy
- Lewis-Sumner syndrome
- Miller Fisher syndrome
- ...

PDMPs access is a key /  
only option for many patients  
- ↘ Symptoms / ↗ HRQoL



## Debilitating diseases

- Weakness of 4 members / respiratory muscles
- Progressive / rapid paralysis
- Death (over 5% GBS)
- Loss of reflexes, loss of balance
- Loss of ability to walk, pain, tremor, fatigue...



## To meet patient needs Future BTC regulation



- Plasma as a European strategic resource
- ≠ between blood and plasma collection
- Co-existence between several actors
- Plasmapheresis, a key to collect more plasma in Europe
- Increase plasma collection / while respecting European cultural and ethical common values
- Increase donor's monitoring ; Collect accurate data in each country annually; Promote and support awareness programs for plasma donation including the creation of an annually dedicated day or period
- VNRD preference BUT need for a clear VUD definition including incentives & compensation, financial neutrality principle
- Consider equity of access throughout Europe - Donors ethics and protection = Patients ethics and protection.
